4. The project manager will then issue the invoice.
5. When the project is paid for, we add it to our project record system, and our programmer starts working.
6. During the work on the project, we give you a link to our test server where you are able to view the work in progress.
7. If you need to communicate with our programmers during the course of the project, you should submit your message to the project ticket in our Customer Help Desk system.
8. As soon as the project is finished and you give your approval, our engineer either uploads the custom changes and updates to your server or send you the updated files along with instructions on where to place those updated files.

How much does it cost?

Each customization project will be priced individually depending on the complexity of the work to be done. You can get a quote for your project by sending us a request via the [contact form](#).
